04 **Trivento Chardonnay/Chenin** | ARGENTINA 175ml £2.90 250ml £3.90 Bottle £11.50  
Just off dry, soft and spicy on the finish. If you want something uncomplicated don't go out with a Scorpio, order this wine instead

05 **Vina Arazu Blanco** | SPAIN £3.05 £4.05 £11.95  
Great quaffing wine! Dry but full of lovely summer fruit

06 **Undurruga Sauvignon Blanc** | CHILE £3.20 £4.30 £12.95  
Gooseberry aromas and honey texture, drinks well with most anything on the menu

07 **Domaine de Pellehaut Rose** | FRANCE £3.30 £4.35 £13.50  
This is our only rosé on the list but it's a great one from the top Bordeaux house of Sichel – just off dry showing nice structure and light strawberry fruit

08 **Marquis de la Menardiere Sauvignon Blanc** | FRANCE £13.95  
A completely refreshing mouthful of green fruit to enliven a fish or cream based dish

09 **Caber Ridge Sem/Sauv/Chardonnay** | AUSTRALIA £14.50  
A glass of pure sunshine in your hand – just don't look out the window and ruin the effect!

10 **Explorer Gewurztraminer** | CHILE £14.95  
Rich, off dry, spicy and exotic. Fantastic with any food that has a kick to it

11 **Hutton Ridge Chenin Blanc** | SOUTH AFRICA £15.10  
If you want something just short of dry but still a good 20 minute drive from sweet then this is just the ticket for you

12 **Weighbridge Chardonnay** | AUSTRALIA £15.50  
Big flavours of soft tropical fruits from the award winning Peter Lehmann

13 **Verdicchio dei Castelli** | ITALY £16.95  
Ok so you've never heard of the grape but think Italian – suave and stylish with a delightfully sharp tongue and long finish

14 **Pinot Grigio Zenato** ITALY £18.80  
Unlike most Pinot Grigio's this actually has flavour – honey and apples make this by far the most popular white on the list

15 **Seifried Estate Sauvignon Blanc** | NEW ZEALAND £19.60  
Fresh granny smith apples with zingy acidity. What New Zealanders do best (apart from travel)

16 **Alsace Riesling Reserve** FRANCE £19.95  
An absolutely classic dry Alsace riesling – get past the unfashionable packaging to find a wine that never goes out of style

17 **Sancerre Premier Cru Saget** | FRANCE £21.50  
If your first instinct was to go for Bin 15, try this godfather of Sauvignon's for a change – sometimes the old ways are still the best

18 **Chablis Tremblay** | FRANCE £21.95  
Elegant mineral flavours in this lovely crisp Chablis
